ABOUT THIS PROJECT

+ Central community hub for Port Coquitlam residents, replacing the aging library and recreation facility while retaining parts of the existing structure.

- + Updated facility features two ice rinks, one 750 seat spectator rink, a swimming pool, a library, multi-purpose rooms, a café, a gymnasium, a fitness centre, an outdoor amphitheater, and pickleball courts.
- + Smith + Andersen engaged as the electrical consultant for the project.
- + Served the facility by an indoor unit substation.
- + Exterior lighting utilizes energy efficient LED fixtures that are dark sky compliant.
- + Provided LED fixtures throughout the interior of the facility.
- + Included daylight and occupancy sensors, scenic dimming, and astronomical time clocks.
